



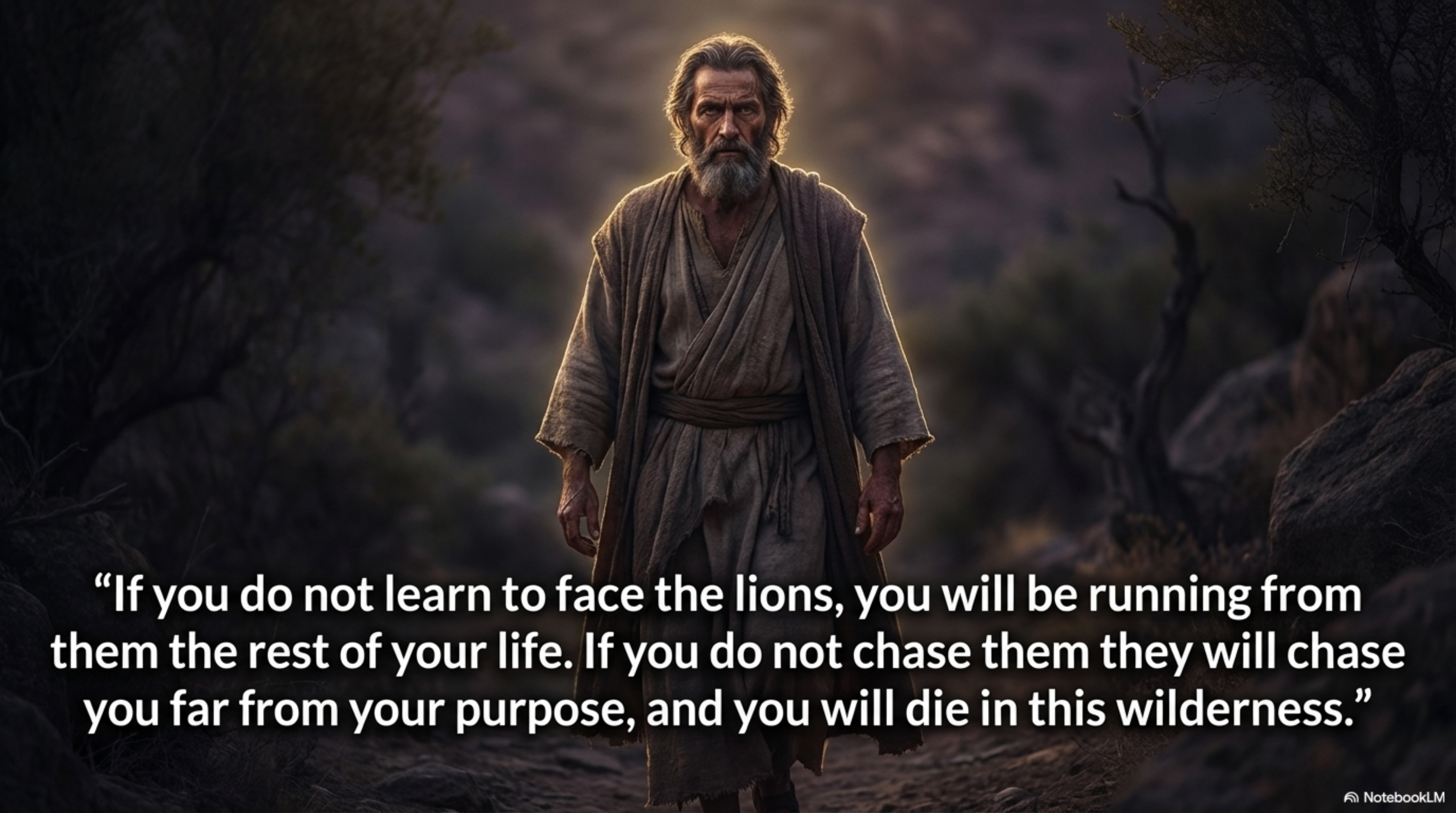
The Lion that is in you, is greater.

“Mary, what are some of your biggest questions?” I inquired.

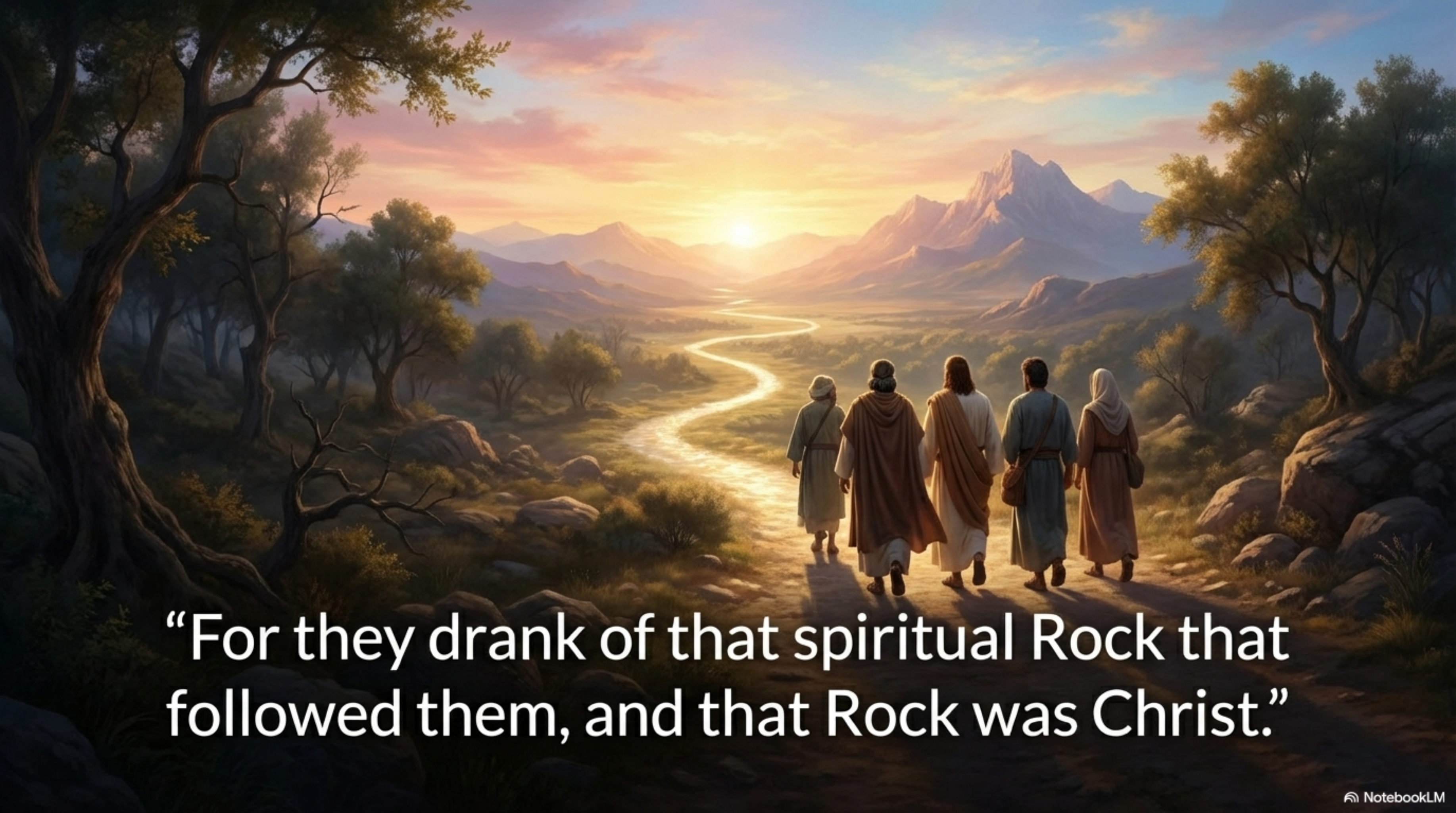
“You know, I think the biggest question, has already been answered,” Mary said, as I noticed tears running down her cheeks.
