# THE TWO MODELS FOR AN AGE TO COME



The journey begins with a question for the guide, the Voice: Who are the 'mighty ones' prophesied to come? The answer lies in understanding two figures who prepared the way for the Lord.

*"These 'messengers of power' will walk with the Lord like Enoch, and they will reveal His power like I did."*



# THE POWER OF LOVE IS THE FINAL EQUATION



The Voice explains the distinction: "I had the power, but Enoch had the greatest love for God." Enoch's love was so profound that God became his very life. The coming messengers must unite these two virtues.

*"At the end of this age, His messengers will have both the love for God, that Enoch had, and the power that I had. Their power will be the power of the love of God."*



# THE ANATOMY OF COURAGE



*“Love, combined with power,  
power, results in courage.  
Courage is the result of loving  
others, more than yourself..*

*Where you are going, you will  
face the greatest trials and  
the greatest dangers. To walk  
this path, will take the  
greatest courage, so you  
must seek the greatest  
greatest love and the  
and the power of  
that love.”*



# A TIME WHEN GOOD AND EVIL BOTH RIPEN



The Voice warns that just as God's "messengers of power" will be consumed with Him, so too will the "sons of perdition" be consumed with evil. The time is close for both to be fully revealed on the earth. This is the harvest at the end of the age.

*"The children of light have never been further from being ready, for what is coming upon them. Never have we had more to do and less time to do it in."*



# ALL WILL ENTER THE VALLEY OF DECISION



A coming manifestation of God's glory will cause everyone on earth to choose a side. This revelation will not convert those who serve evil; it will only cause them to hate the light more, just as they hated Jesus despite his miracles.

*"The glory that will soon be manifested, will cause everyone on earth to enter the Valley of Decision, where they must choose... Before the nations come to the light, they must see the conflict, between the light and the darkness, once again."*



# THE FIRST CONFLICT IS THE FINAL CONFLICT



The ultimate struggle is between two forms of sacrifice. Cain brought the fruit of his own works and self-righteousness. Abel brought the blood of the lamb, a sacrifice received by faith. This remains the core of all spiritual warfare.

*“You must confront the false religions, the false worship, and all that is based on the works, sacrifices, and self-righteousness of men. You must confront it, by standing on the works of God. The cross is your message.”*



# THE ULTIMATE DELUSION: SELF-PROMOTION



The Voice warns that there is no greater corruption than using God's things to draw worship to oneself. This delusion is the opposite of the way of the cross. Those who "are not" because they have lost themselves in God cannot fall to this.

***"Self-promotion reveals a basic delusion. It would be like the donkey that Jesus rode into Jerusalem, thinking all of the adulation was for it."***



# THE LIE THAT DISARMED A PROPHET

The protagonist admits to feeling that his work has been in vain.

The Voice reveals this same thinking—feeling he was the only one left—is what made him “useless to the Lord.” This is a departure from the path.

*“When I began to feel the same way—that I was the only one left—I became useless to the Lord, and He had to remove me... If we look at what He is doing, we will always be encouraged, and always rejoicing. If we look at ourselves, we will always be depressed. Don’t go there again.”*





# YOUR DESTINATION IS THE MOUNTAIN OF THE LORD



The protagonist's destination is his true home: the Mountain of the Lord, where God dwells. This mountain has been in continuous battle and is growing, as prophesied by Daniel. It is the greatest threat to the enemy's domain.

***"The mountain of the house of the Lord, will soon challenge everyone on earth. The ultimate battle is close at hand, and the mountain will be the battlefield."***



# THE WORK IS TO BUILD THE BUILDERS



The Voice encourages the protagonist, revealing that he has already been helping to build the mountain without realizing it by guiding others to it. His labor has not been in vain.

*“You must lead all who come to this path, to the mountain. They must find their place on it. That is how you will help prepare the way for the Lord.”*



# THE PATH LEADS BACK TO THE BEGINNING



As they walk, the path widens and breaks out of the forest. The protagonist is shocked to find himself at the exact same place where his wilderness journey first began, with a cruise ship offloading passengers.

*“What are we doing back here? I thought we were on the path to the mountain? ... Did I fail the test of this wilderness, so that I must go through it again?”*



# THE NEXT TEST IS NOT FOR YOU ALONE



*“You did not fail. This is the next test, and it is a bigger one. You cannot go further until you have brought others as far as you have gone... It will be easier, because you will not forget to drink the living water. It will be harder because you will have these people with you.”*



# WE ARE READY TO GO



The protagonist turns to ask another question, but The Voice is gone. An officer from the ship, followed by dozens of people, walks directly up to him. The officer's words are simple, direct, and immediate, thrusting protagonist into his new role without any further preparation.

*"We are ready to go,"  
the young officer said.*
