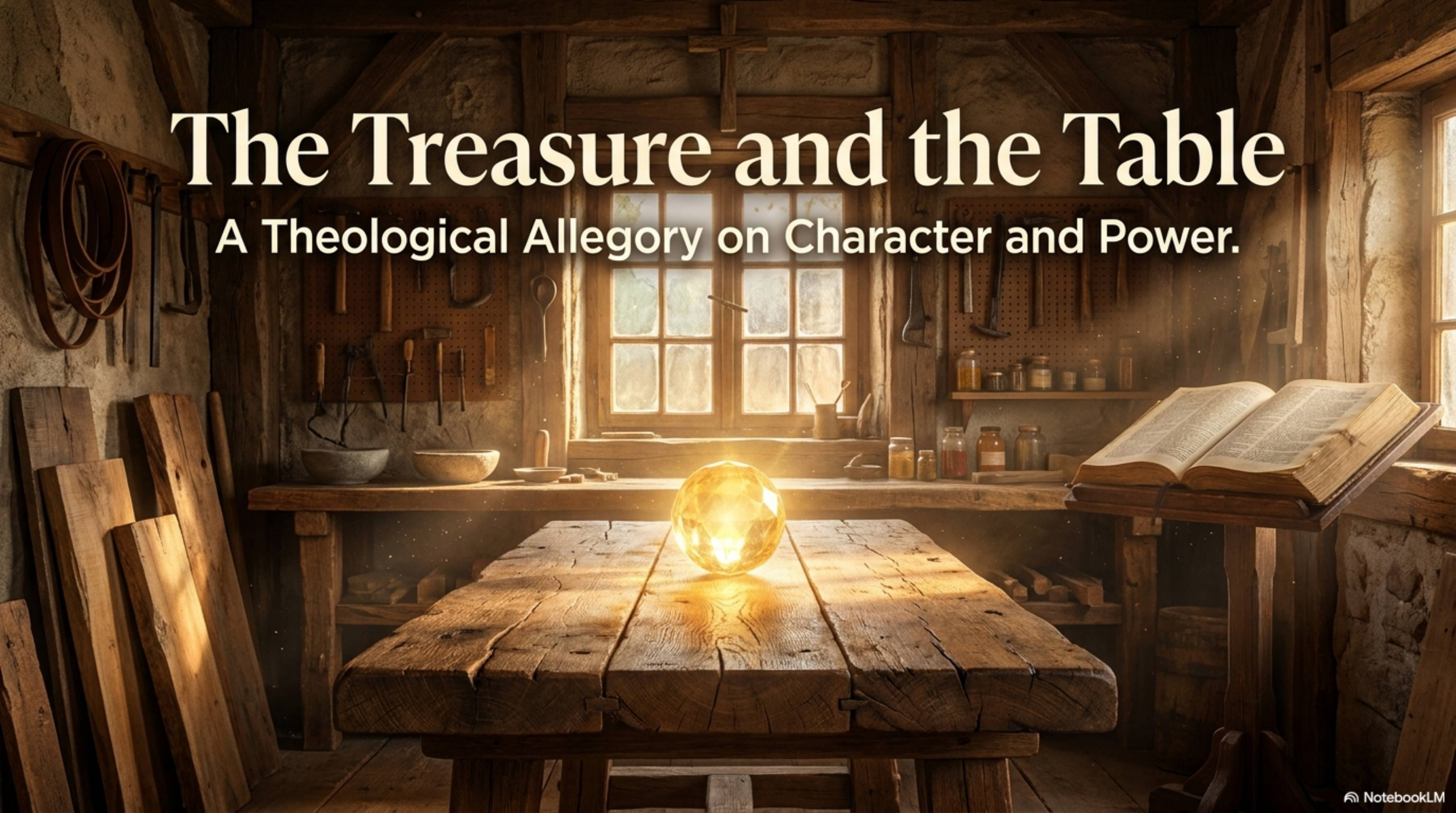


The Treasure and the Table

searching for more treasure.

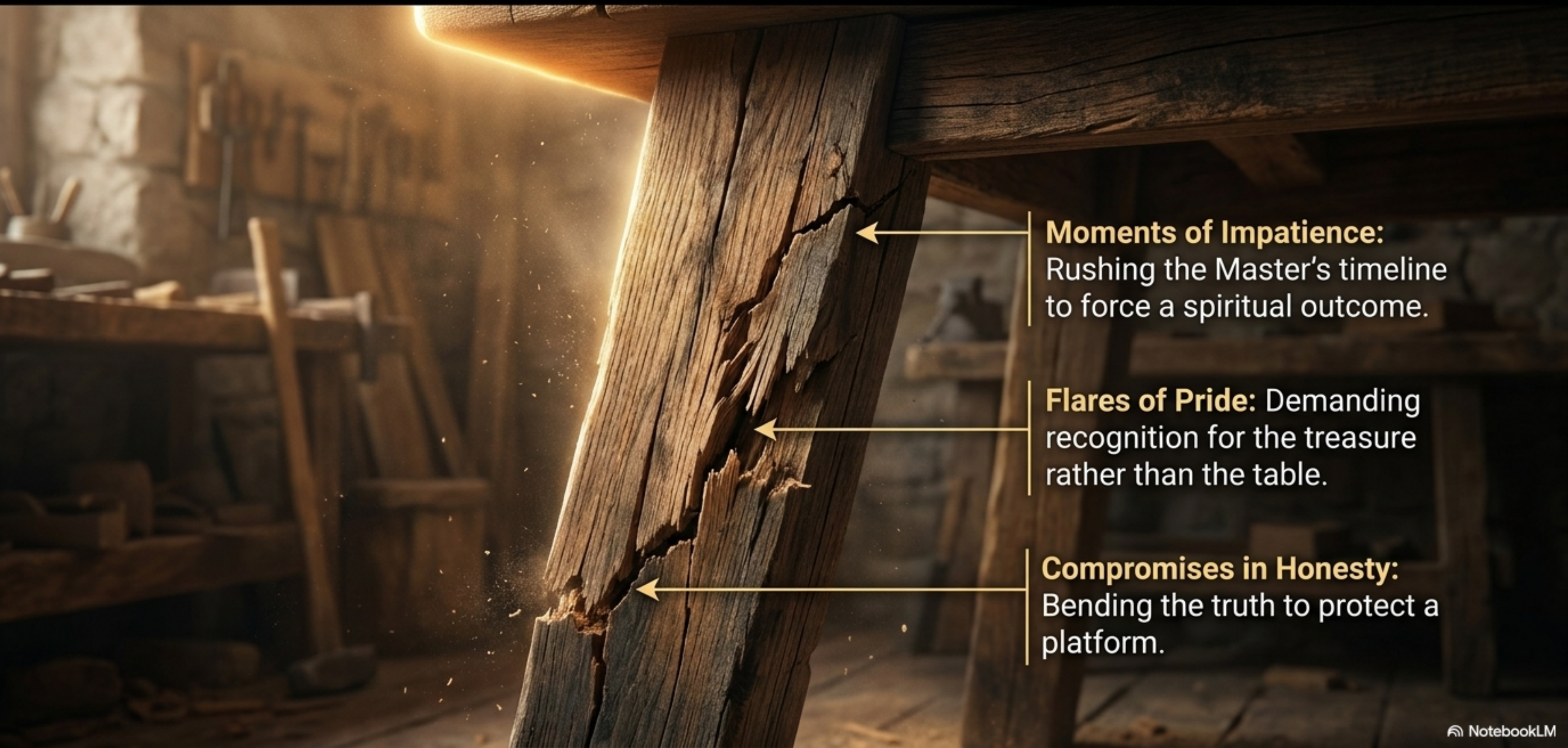
He is actively searching for people
