The name of this mini-book is called Revelation 22 because the book of Revelation is the revelation of Christ and the eternal victory of God's kingdom and the complete defeat and destruction of the authority of kingdom of darkness. This 22 day devotional will help you declare and obtain your victory in life in Christ through scripture, the teaching of numerous champions of faith and my own experience of freedom in Christ. I highly recommend that you get and stay connected to other believers for prayer partnership and support. This tool is to support you along your growth into the freedom Jesus Christ has paid for, in full, on the cross and through his resurrection.

These teaching and prayers were powerful in my own journey of deliverance from the demonic oppression from which I had suffered under for years. The curse is broken. The enemy is defeated. Freedom is yours in Christ. **Expect breakthrough.**

Day 1 – Confession of Faith

Bible Verses

- **Romans 6:23** “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (NKJV)
- **Romans 10:9** “that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.” (NIV)
- **Romans 10:13** “For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” (NKJV)
- **Matthew 7:7** “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you.” (NIV)
- **Mark 16:16** “Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.” (NIV)
- **Romans 3:23** “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,” (NKJV)

Discussion

The first and most important step for life and deliverance is to call on the name of Jesus and submit your whole life to Him. This includes repenting for your sins, which is turning away from those sins, receiving forgiveness, and accepting Him and His ways as your Lord

and Savior. Jesus paid for sin and the punishment of all mankind on the cross. Accepting Jesus and getting baptized is the foundation for all deliverance, healing, and sanctification. It is also the beginning of a beautiful relationship with the lover of your soul, who loved you so much that He gave His life to rescue and restore you.

Prayer (Read each of the following Prayers out loud.)

Jesus, I admit that I am a sinner, that I have fallen short of the glory of God. Jesus, I repent for my sins, and I ask you to forgive me. I renounce Satan and all his works. Jesus, I believe that you were born, lived a sinless life, and then died on the cross for my sins. I believe that you were raised to life on the third day and that you now sit at the right hand of the Father interceding on my behalf. I confess with my mouth and believe in my heart that Jesus Christ is Lord. I ask you, Jesus, to be my God and my source of life, to be my Lord and Savior, to be the King on the throne of my heart. I submit my life and my will to you; may your will be done in my life.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 2 – Faith to Believe

Bible Verses

- **Matthew 17:20** “So Jesus said to them, ‘Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, “Move from here to there,” and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.” (NKJV)
- **Mark 9:24** “Immediately the boy’s father exclaimed, ‘I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!’” (NIV)
- **Mark 11:22-24** “Have faith in God,’ Jesus answered. “Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, “Go, throw yourself into the sea,” and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.” (NIV)
- **Romans 10:17** “So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”(NKJV)
- **Hebrews 11:1** “Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.” (NIV)
- **Hebrews 11:6** “And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.” (NIV)

Discussion

Faith is believing that Jesus is who He says He is, and that we can do what He says He can do. And that His Word is true. The Bible is filled with testimonies of people who were healed and delivered because of their faith.

Unbelief is doubting or not believing what the Word of God says is true, and believing lies of the enemy. Even the disciples were not able to cast the demon out of the boy (the epileptic boy in Matthew 17:14-21). When they asked Jesus, “Why could we not cast it out?” Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief.”

Prayer

Jesus, please help me with my unbelief. I believe, Jesus, that you are the truth and the truth sets us free. I ask you, Jesus, to cleanse my mind, my will, and my emotions of any lies of the enemy I’ve believed, and I repent for all unbelief. I ask you, Jesus, to give me eyes to see, ears to hear, and a mouth to speak your Word. I ask you, Jesus, for a gift of faith, the kind of faith that can move a mountain. Thank you, Jesus.

In Jesus’ name, Amen.

Day 3 – Pleading the Blood of Jesus

Bible Verses

- **Exodus 12:7** “Then they are to take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the door frames of the houses where they eat the lambs.” (NIV)
- **Exodus 12:13** “The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are, and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt.” (NIV)
- **Ephesians 1:7** “In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace.” (NIV)
- **Hebrews 9:14** “Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God. For by the power of the eternal Spirit, Christ offered himself to God as a perfect sacrifice for our sins.” (NLT)
- **1 Peter 1:18-19** “knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.” (NKJV)

Discussion

The blood of lambs was used for sacrifice to God as payment and restoration from the damage of sin. During the Old Testament Passover in Exodus Chapter 12, the Israelites were instructed to put the blood of a lamb on the top of the door frames of the houses where they ate the lambs. The blood would be a sign, and they would be protected from the plague striking all the firstborn sons of Egypt, both man and beast. At the Cross of Calvary, Jesus, an innocent man, became the sacrificial lamb and paid for all of our sins, and their damage to our lives and the lives of others, with His innocent blood. His resurrection is proof of his successful payment, and now we have the right to freedom and restoration through His blood. There is resurrection power, protection, healing, deliverance, and redemption in the blood of Jesus. It covers our sins, it redeems us, and washes us clean.

Prayer

Thank you, Jesus, for Your sacrifice and Your life-giving Holy blood. Thank you for dying for my sins and the sins of the world, and being the Sacrificial Lamb so I could be redeemed. I plead the blood of Jesus over my mind, over my body, over my soul. I plead the blood of Jesus over my children, over my entire family, over my finances, my health, over every circumstance of my life. I plead the blood of Jesus over my entire bloodline on my father's side and mother's side, all the way back to Adam and Eve and all my generations going forward. I thank you, Jesus, for washing me clean and paying for my restoration through Your Holy blood.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 4 – Repenting and Renouncing Sins

Bible Verses

- **Proverbs 28:13** “Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.” (NIV)
- **Isaiah 1:18** “ ‘Come now, let us settle the matter,’ says the LORD. ‘Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are as red as crimson, they shall be like wool.’”(NIV)
- **Luke 5:31-32** “Jesus answered them, ‘It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.’”(NIV)
- **Acts 2:38** “Peter replied, ‘Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.’” (NIV)
- **James 5:16** “Therefore, confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.”(NIV)

Discussion

Repenting for your sins means turning from the things that you have done, which were violations or breaking God’s law or commandments,

or going against His word or will for your life, and turning back toward God. Sin is defined in scripture in (1 John 3:4) (NIV): “Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness.” And (Romans 3:23) (NIV) says: “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

The first step is to **confess** your sins; this can be done to another person or in prayer to God, or both. The next step is to **repent**, which is to turn away from your sin and restore your direction by returning to God and seeking His ways. Then, **renounce** which is to disown, reject, deny, and come out of agreement with the sinful behavior, actions, or thoughts.

Prayer

Father God, I come humbly before You to ask for forgiveness for the sins I have committed. Please help me to search my heart, Lord, so that I can lay everything before You. I confess that I have committed the following sins: (Fill in the blank) _____

_____ I repent and renounce all of these sins that I have confessed. Thank You Father that You are faithful to forgive me and wash me clean by Your Holy Blood. I thank You Jesus, for paying for my sins and Your power that sets me free.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Day 5 – Bloodline and Generational Curses

Bible Verses

- **Exodus 34:6-7** “And the LORD passed before him and proclaimed, “The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children’s children to the third and the fourth generation.’ ” (NKJV)
- **Deuteronomy 5:9-10** “You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generations of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.” (NIV)
- **Matthew 23:35** And so upon you will come all the righteous blood that has been shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Berekiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar.(NIV)

Discussion

In the same way that inheritance or blessings are passed down from

generation to generation, so can curses of sickness, of death, and of bondage be passed down. It is not a coincidence that everyone in a family has fought the same battles. Addiction, divorce, cancer, and poverty are a few examples of afflictions and curses that run in families. They are demonic spirits and curses that entered through sin, or agreements, identifying with beliefs and patterns, and speaking words of poverty, disease and death. Those sins must be repented for and renounced to break the associated curses, especially with when blood oaths and curses are passed down through generations that are in agreement with demonic powers. Even word curses can affect and put an entire bloodline into bondage. Jesus' victory on the Cross made us free, so we pray this prayer to enforce what He already won.

Prayer

Father, I thank You that in Christ I am a new creation, the old has passed away and all things have become new and all things are of God (2 Corinthians 5:17). I repent of every sin pattern that does not align with Your truth (Acts 3:19), and I receive the cleansing of Jesus' blood (1 John 1:7). I declare that Christ was made a curse for us and redeemed me from every curse (Galatians 3:13), and I will not be conformed to this world but transformed by the renewing of my mind (Romans 12:2). By Your Spirit, I walk in obedience and freedom (Galatians 5:16). I choose righteousness and life (Deuteronomy 30:19). Father God, I thank you that today the bloodline and generational curses end with me. I am a bloodline redeemer. I plead the Blood of Jesus over my entire bloodline on my mother's side and father's side, all the way back to Adam and Eve, and over the generations going forward. I repent and renounce all of my sins and the sins of my ancestors. I break off and nullify every ungodly oath, ungodly dedication, or ungodly vow. I nullify every ungodly blood covenant, contract, or sacrifice and declare them as null and void. In

DAY 5 – BLOODLINE AND GENERATIONAL CURSES

Jesus name I break off every word curse that has been spoken over me or my bloodline, or that I have spoken over myself. I call forth all the redemption, generational blessings and inheritance in Christ for my bloodline.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 6 – Soul Ties

Bible Verses

- **Genesis 2:24** “That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh.” (NIV)
- **Genesis 34:3** “And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel...” (KJV)
- **1 Samuel 18:1** “Now when he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul.” (NKJV)

Discussion

A soul tie is a deep bond, dependency, or connection between two people. It can be emotional, spiritual, sexual, physical, or even psychological. It can be in all types of relationships: a husband and wife, best friends, siblings or even a person with their beloved pet can have a deep soul connection. Some of the ties are healthy, like in a healthy God-fearing and honoring marriage, but when sin or trauma, abuse, compromise, unhealthy and ungodly habits or practices come in, it becomes an ungodly soul tie. In the case of sexual relations this is especially important because the two become one flesh. A bond and connection is established and another persons demons and bondage can start

afflicting the other person.

Prayer

Father God, I lift up every relationship and soul tie in my life. Every God honoring soul tie, I thank you for and ask You to continue to bless. I ask for a Holy Spirit cleansing of these relationships. But every ungodly soul tie that I have entered through sin or any other means, knowingly or unknowingly, I ask you to break those soul ties right now. I give them back their souls whole and complete, washed in the Blood of Jesus. And I take back my soul, whole and complete, washed in the Blood of Jesus.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 7 – Unforgiveness

Bible Verses

- **Mark 11:25** “And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins.” (NIV)
- **Luke 6:37** “Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn others, or it will all come back against you. Forgive others, and you will be forgiven.” (NLT)
- **Luke 23:34** “Jesus said, ‘Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.’ And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.” (NIV)
- **Romans 12:19** “Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, ‘I will take revenge; I will pay them back,’ says the Lord.” (NLT)
- **Ephesians 4:31-32** “Get rid of all bitterness, rage, and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.” (NIV)

Discussion

Unforgiveness, bitterness, anger, rage, hatred, judgment, offense,

revenge, vengeance, gossip, slander, backbiting, and jealousy are all negative emotions and practices that we often experience when someone has hurt or wronged us. We feel justified because we believe that they should get consequences for their actions. Jesus came and paid for all of our sins and showed us a whole different way of doing things. In (Luke 6:28) (NIV), Jesus says: “Bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.” We don’t forgive people because they deserve it. We forgive because Jesus paid for all sin and forgave us when we didn’t deserve it.

Prayer

Father God, I repent and renounce all unforgiveness, bitterness, anger, rage, hatred, judgment, offense, revenge, vengeance, gossip, slander, backbiting, and jealousy. I ask You to search my heart. If I have anything in my heart against anyone, or any unforgiveness towards anyone, I ask You to reveal it to me right now.

Father God, I lift up (Fill in blank) _____
_____ to You. If there is any unforgiveness or negative emotions I have toward them, I ask You to help me to forgive them because love keeps no record of wrongs. I choose now to forgive them. I release them from all judgment, and I ask You to bless them.

In Jesus’ name, Amen.

Day 8 – Trauma and Rejection

Bible Verses

- **Psalms 82:3** “Give justice to the poor and the orphan; uphold the rights of the oppressed and the destitute.(NLT)
- **Isaiah 53:3** “He was despised and rejected—a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care. (NLT)
- **Matthew 11:28-30** “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (NIV)
- **Romans 8:1** “There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.”(NKJV)
- **Romans 8:15** “For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, ‘Abba, Father.’ ” (NKJV)
- **Ephesians 1:5** “He predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will.” (NIV)

Discussion

Spiritual bondage comes in through many different ways. The way we are treated by the people around us sow seeds in us. Those seeds take root, and as they grow, they bring forth a harvest. Seeds of love and righteousness bring forth a healthy harvest in our lives and spiritual walk. Trauma, rejection, abandonment, guilt, shame, and condemnation come in through physical, mental, emotional, verbal, and spiritual abuse or neglect, and bring forth a harvest of bondage. Jesus has the power to break you free from these chains of bondage.

Prayer

Father God, I thank you for sending your precious Son, Jesus, to break these chains of bondage off my life. Jesus took my rejection, pain, grief and sorrow on himself so I would be free. I forgive everyone who has hurt me. I repent, renounce, and break every generational curse of trauma, rejection, all forms of abuse, abandonment, guilt, shame, condemnation, and the orphan spirit for my life and my entire bloodline. I break every negative word, label, or false identity that has been spoken over me or that I have believed. I forgive anyone who has abused me or caused bondage in my life. I break off every yoke of bondage off my neck and off of my life. Any burdens that are not mine to carry, I give to You, Jesus. I thank You, Jesus, for making my yoke easy and my burden light. I thank You, Jesus, for a Holy Spirit cleansing and reset of every cell of my body, including down to the cellular memory. I am not an orphan; I am a blood-bought child of the King.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 9 – Fear, Anxiety, Depression

Bible Verses

- **Proverbs 9:10** “The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.” (NKJV)
- **Isaiah 41:10** “Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”(NKJV)
- **2 Timothy 1:7** “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.” (NKJV)
- **1 John 4:18** “There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.” (NKJV)

Discussion

In the King James Version (KJV) of the Bible, “Fear not” is written over 70 times. Other phrases like “do not be afraid” or “be not dismayed” are also used. This same message, with different wording, varying depending on translation methods. The main message is that God does not want us living in fear, so much so that it is considered to be the most repeated command in the Bible. We were not created for fear. Fear is the opposite of faith. Worry, anxiety, depression, and fear are all from

the enemy to distract us, put us in bondage, and make us lose faith in God and His promises. The only fear we should have is the fear of the Lord. That does not mean being afraid of Him. It is having respect, awe, reverence, and wonder of His greatness, and giving Him all the honor and glory.

Prayer

Father God, I thank You for Your word that tells us not to fear and tells us not to be afraid. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of fear, of worry, of anxiety, of depression. I repent and renounce all fear of man, fear of sickness, fear of lack, fear of death, fear of the future, or any other ungodly fears. I repent and renounce all irrational fears and phobias and all ungodly coping mechanisms that I have leaned on for relief. I bind every lie and intimidation tactic of the enemy, and put all my fears and worries at Your feet.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 10 – Infirmary and Disease

Bible Verses

- **Psalms 103:2-3** “Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases.” (NKJV)
- **Psalms 107:20** “He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.” (NKJV)
- **Proverbs 18:21** “The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.” (NLT)
- **Isaiah 53:5** “But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.” (NIV)
- **Matthew 8:17** “This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: ‘He took our infirmities and bore our diseases.’ ” (NIV)

Discussion

Jesus is the great physician and the mighty healer. He paid for all sins and all healing at the cross. All through the Bible, there are accounts of Jesus healing all types of sickness and disease and conditions: Leprosy, paralysis, blindness, deafness, muteness, seizures, issues of blood, and

even death. In (Matthew 17:14-18), Jesus heals a demon-possessed boy. He had seizures and would often fall into the fire or water. Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him, and he was healed at that moment. Although some sicknesses are demonic or from bloodline curses, not all of them are. Some can be from environmental exposure or hazards, or from many other sources. The origin of sickness or disease doesn't matter. Jesus is always the solution.

Prayer

Jesus, I thank you for dying on the cross for our sins and for our healing. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of sickness and disease. I repent and renounce all physical disorders, mental illness, and all diagnoses of disease. I break every word, curse, or diagnosis from doctors or test results and I call on the resurrection power of Jesus, the same power that raised Christ from the dead! I ask you, Jesus, to wash clean every negative diagnosis spoken over me. I command all sickness, all disease, all cancer, and mental disorders to be removed and cast into the pit. I declare that I am healed by the finished work that Jesus did on the Cross.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 11 – Lust and Sexual Sin / Addiction

Bible Verses

- **Matthew 5:28-29** “But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you; for it is better for you to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.” (NIV)
- **1 Corinthians 6:18-20** “Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually sins against their own body. Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies.” (NIV)
- **Galatians 5:19-21** “works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I told you in the past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.”(NKJV)
- **Hebrews 13:4** “Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the

sexually immoral.” (NIV)

Discussion

Lust of the eyes, lust of the flesh are a desire for things that God forbids. The Bible makes it clear that any sexual relations outside of the marriage covenant are sexual sin. Sex within marriage is not only for procreation but for bonding and can even be considered a form of worship. Our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit and should glorify God in all the things that we do. In an age of instant gratification, falling into sexual sin or addiction has become the normal and acceptable, but the Bible clearly shows that it is sin. All sin has its own consequences. Most people worry about sexually transmitted diseases, but you can also get sexually transferred demons, as you become one with whoever you are having sex with. This can lead to demonic oppression, sexual demons like Incubus and Succubus, and other ungodly spirits. Addiction to drugs, alcohol, pornography or anything is considered sin and causes bondage and destruction. Jesus came to set us free from all bondage and destructive behaviors.

Prayer

Father God, Please forgive me for any sins that I have done against my own body. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of sexual immorality, lust, perversion, fornication, masturbation, adultery, orgies, sodomy, incest, bestiality, rape, prostitution, and all other sexual sin, pornography, gluttony, and all forms of addiction. I renounce every demon or ungodly spirit that came in through those sins. I thank You Jesus, that You came to set the captives free, and who the Son sets free, is free indeed!

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 12 – Idol Worship and False gods

Bible Verses

- **Exodus 20:3** “You shall have no other gods before me.” (NIV)
- **Exodus 23:24** “You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars.” (NKJV)
- **Psalms 115:8** “And those who make idols are just like them, as are all who trust in them.” (NLT)
- **Isaiah 42:8** “I am the LORD; that is My name! I will not yield My glory to another or My praise to idols.” (NIV)
- **Matthew 6:24** “No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.” (NKJV)

Discussion

Idols are lifeless objects created by human hands, often carved from wood or stone or forged from metal. They often represent demons, false gods, or goddesses. They do not speak or hear, love or save, but many people sacrifice or offer sacrifices of money, food, animals, human beings, and even babies. They worship these statues and believe that

they give them good fortune, protection, power, or enlightenment. In the Bible (Judges 6:25-32), Gideon was instructed by the Lord to tear down his father's altar to Baal, and the Asherah pole next to it, which represented Canaanite deities. In Exodus 32, the Israelites created a golden idol in the shape of a calf and started sacrificing and bowing down to it and claiming it was the god that brought them out of Egypt. Idol worship isn't only about false gods or statues or objects representing them. Idol worship is anything that a person exalts above God. A few examples are all religious figures, money, possessions, career, social media, celebrities or politicians.

Prayer

Father God, I ask for your forgiveness for anything or anyone I have put before You. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of idol worship or worshiping of false gods. All sun and moon gods, fertility gods, gods of war, gods of fortune, gods of the elements, of the snake or serpent, Egyptian, Hindu, Greek, Aztec, Nordic, or any other gods or goddesses from any origin; all spirit animals, totem spirits, ancestral spirits, all worship of the dead, of any false religion, figures or cult leaders; all charms, statues, or any objects that represented these gods or goddesses or anything else that I went to for healing, protection, or any other benefits. I break every connection with any of these things. I ask You, God, to forgive me and help me to keep my eyes fixed on You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 13 – False Religion and Cults

Bible Verses

- **Matthew 7:15** “Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.” (NIV)
- **John 14:6** “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’ ” (NIV)
- **Ephesians 2:8-9** “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.” (NIV)
- **2 Timothy 3:16** All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. (ESV)

Discussion

False religions and cults are social groups that have theology that is false or distorted or a mixture of teachings and belief systems that do not line up with Biblical Christianity and doctrine. It is often based on works or merit rather than God’s grace and faith in Jesus Christ. They deny the deity of Christ and the trinity, and many of the core teachings and beliefs of the Bible. There are many times a single dynamic leader

is elevated and even worshiped. They use other books in addition to or instead of the Bible, but these books are inspired and written by man's thoughts and opinions, and these, rather than the Bible, are used for their foundational teaching. They usually claim some kind of hidden knowledge or enlightenment, works-based salvation, secrecy, exclusivity, and gaining of privilege, power, and status as you rise up on a man-made hierarchy.

Prayer

Father God, I believe that the written Word of the Holy Bible is true. I acknowledge and believe in the deity of Jesus Christ and the Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. I thank You, God, that You have made a way for me through grace by faith in Jesus. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of free masonry, Buddhism or any other false religion and cults for my life and my entire bloodline, all the way back to Adam and Eve. I break all soul ties with any false prophets, leaders, or teachers. I give them back their souls whole and complete, washed in the Blood of Jesus, and I take back my soul whole and complete, washed in the Blood of Jesus. I ask you, Father, to remove any false teachings or doctrine that I have received, knowingly or unknowingly. I break every curse, every ungodly sacrifice, oath, ungodly covenant, dedication, ceremony, or ritual that was done by me or on my behalf.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 14 – Jezebel / Ahab

Bible Verses

- **1 Kings 16:31** “And it came to pass, as though it had been a trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took as wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal, King of the Sidonians; and he went and served Baal and worshiped him.” (NKJV)
- **1 Kings 18:4** “While Jezebel was killing off the LORD’s prophets, Obadiah had taken a hundred prophets and hidden them in two caves, fifty in each, and had supplied them with food and water.” (NIV)
- **1 Kings 21:25** “But there was no one like Ahab who sold himself to do wickedness in the sight of the LORD, because Jezebel his wife stirred him up.” (NKJV)
- **Revelation 2:20** “Nevertheless, I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet. By her teaching, she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols.” (NIV)

Discussion

Jezebel in the Bible was a Phoenician princess who married King Ahab of Israel and became a wicked queen. She was best known for her dominating spirit and for dominating her husband. She worshiped Baal and Asherah, pagan gods, and influenced her husband to do the same. They built a temple and altar for Baal and worshiped him, and put an Asherah pole up to worship Asherah, the consort of Baal. They made sacrifices to Baal and encouraged the Israelites to worship Baal. She was also known for persecuting and killing God's prophets. The Jezebel Spirit is used to describe a spiritual or demonic influence with traits of witchcraft, control, manipulation, seduction, sexual immorality, idol worship, domination, hatred of men and men's authority, lack of submission, and attack on prophets of God. The Ahab Spirit is usually very submissive and passive, and gives over authority to a dominant partner, moral weakness, and is easily manipulated and controlled.

Prayer

Father God, please search my heart and my ways. If I have any of the characteristics of Jezebel or Ahab, I ask you to remove those from me now. Convict my heart and show me any behaviors that I need to change. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of the spirit of Jezebel, of witchcraft, control, manipulation, seduction, sexual immorality, idol worship, domination, hatred of male or God-ordained authority, lack of submission, and any way that I have not honored my husband and, most importantly, any way that I have not honored God. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of Ahab, of being overly submissive, passive, moral weakness, or being easily manipulated.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 15 – Mind Control / Marine Spirits / Ungodly Media

Bible Verses

- **Psalms 101:3** “I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me.” (NKJV)
- **Psalm 119:37** “Turn my eyes from looking at worthless things; and give me life in your ways.”(ESV)
- **Romans 12:2** “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.” (NIV)
- **Philippians 4:8** “Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.”(NKJV)

Discussion

In many deliverance ministries marine spirits refer to water spirits, representing chaos, evil and the demonic. There are many references in the Bible to chaos and evil opposing God’s Kingdom coming from

the sea: Leviathan, the Sea Serpent, and the Beast of Revelation rising from the sea. Marine Spirits and the Marine Kingdom are considered in many charismatic Christian teachings to be demonic, causing bondage in the form of sexual sin, finances, spirit spouses, infertility, and various other types of spiritual oppression. How do they get in? People invite them in. Entry points are through the bloodline, through acts of sexual sin and perversion, or a person's own sin. Pornography, ungodly media, and chronic masturbation are all entry points for marine spirits that can result in demonic oppression, mind control, confusion, spirit spouses, sexual attacks in dreams and in severe cases oppression even while awake, and sexual demons including common ones referred to as incubus and succubus.

Prayer

Father God, You are the Creator of the heavens and the earth. Please forgive me for any sins that I have committed that have allowed marine spirits to come in. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of any and all water spirits and marine entities, all sexual demons including incubus and succubus, all mind control, all mind binding spirits, pornography, all sexual sin and perversion, adultery, fantasy, chronic masturbation, all ungodly media, confusion, and all spirit spouses that came in through ungodly media or any other source. I repent and renounce all ungodly soul ties with the marine kingdom or spirit spouse or marriages with any marine spirits that I entered into, knowingly or unknowingly. I ask you to nullify any ungodly covenant or dedication or sacrifice to the marine kingdom in my life or by my ancestors on my behalf. I ask for a Holy Spirit cleansing of my eye gates, ear gates, my mind, and my sexual and reproductive organs.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 16 – New Age / False Holy Spirit

Bible Verses

- **John 14:6** “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’ ” (NIV)
- **1 Corinthians 10:21** “You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons too; you cannot have a part in both the Lord’s table and the table of demons.” (NIV)
- **Colossians 2:8** “See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.” (NIV)
- **1 John 2:22** “Who is the liar? It is whoever denies that Jesus is the Christ. Such a person is the antichrist—denying the Father and the Son.” (NIV)

Discussion

New Age is a practice in which it is believed that divine energy or enlightenment is achieved through a divine force that opens the person up to self-divinity and a supposed enlightenment or awakening. Many New Age practices are borrowed from Eastern religions such as Hinduism. Some examples are yoga, meditation, karma, reincarnation,

opening of chakras, channeling, astral projection, psychics, the zodiac, astrology, numerology, reiki, and tarot cards. In New Age practices, a divine universal force is believed to be within everyone, and that through these methods, one can open up to higher consciousness or enlightenment. New Age rejects the Christian doctrine of sin, repentance, salvation by Jesus, and divine judgment. The Bible prohibits many New Age beliefs: idol worship, divination, consulting spirits, and false teachings. Kundalini Awakening is a new-age practice in which it is believed that a coiled energy rises up the spine and reaches the head, allowing a fire serpent to activate and open chakras. This is believed to produce self-realization and a higher consciousness. Kundalini is considered a counterfeit or false version of the Holy Spirit, mimicking the move of the spirit but focusing on exaltation of self rather than following Jesus.

Prayer

Father God, I come humbly before, submitted fully to You in Christ and ask forgiveness for the sins I have committed involving any New Age practices or beliefs. I repent and renounce yoga, the opening of chakras, tantras, tantric sex, mantras, rituals, yantras, meditation, channeling, psychics, mediums, spirit guides, gurus, the zodiac, astrology, numerology, reiki, tarot cards, Kundalini, astral projection, and all false beliefs of self-divinity, karma, and reincarnation. I repent and renounce all false teachings, idol worship, serpent gods or goddesses, consulting spirits, divination, and any and all false gods or goddesses or practices of New Age, Hinduism, eastern mysticism or any other false religion practices. I break every soul tie with any spirit guide, teacher, guru, medium, mentor, or leader that led me in any of these practices. I give them back their souls, whole and complete, washed in the Blood of Jesus, and I take back my soul, whole and complete, washed

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in the Blood of Jesus, closing every demonic portal, sealing it with the Blood of Jesus. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 17 – Witchcraft / Divination

Bible Verses

- **Exodus 22:18** “Do not allow a sorceress to live.” (NIV)
- **Leviticus 19:31** “Do not turn to mediums or seek out spiritists, for you will be defiled by them.” (NIV)
- **Leviticus 20:27** “A man or woman who is a medium or spiritist among you must be put to death. You are to stone them; their blood will be on their own heads.” (NIV)
- **Deuteronomy 18:10** “Let no one be found among you who sacrifices their son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead.” (NIV)
- **1 Samuel 15:23** “For rebellion is like the sin of divination, and arrogance like the evil of idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has rejected you as king.” (NIV)
- **Ezekiel 18:23** “Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares the Lord God, and not rather that he should turn from his way and live?”(ESV)

Discussion

Witchcraft, sorcery, necromancy, divination, and all other forms of

magic are all seen as rebellion towards God or works of the flesh. Seeking supernatural sources or realms rather than God for guidance, wisdom, and knowledge. In the book of (Acts 16:16-18), Paul and Silas met a female slave who had a “spirit of divination.” In the original Greek, this translates to “spirit of python.” Paul cast it out of the girl because it was a demonic or unclean spirit associated with false religion. Even though information obtained through these sources can have some truth, the information is coming from an impure source and is an abomination to God. Prophecy comes only from God; Divination comes from other sources and is false or deceptive.

Prayer

Father God, please forgive me for any rebellion or works of the flesh. Please forgive me for any ways that I have sought guidance, wisdom, and knowledge from any other supernatural source or realm rather than You, God. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of rebellion, witchcraft, divination, sorcery, necromancy, mediums, psychics, fortune tellers, horoscopes, astrology, the python spirit, the coiling serpent, and any other demonic or unclean spirits associated with these practices. I ask you, God, to nullify and break the power of every spell, hex, vex, incantation, psychic prediction, palm or tarot card reading, taboo, voodoo, jinxes, chants, word curses, black magic, white magic, Santeria, all party games involving witchcraft or divination including Ouija board, light as a feather, stiff as a board, bloody Mary or any other demonic things that I participated in, knowingly or unknowingly. I close every demonic portal that I opened and seal it with the Blood of Jesus. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

Day 18 – Pride / Leviathan

Bible Verses

- **Job 41:1** “Can you draw out Leviathan with a hook, or snare his tongue with a line which you lower?” (NKJV)
- **Job 41:33-34** “On earth there is nothing like him, which is made without fear. He beholds every high thing; He is king over all the children of pride.(NKJV)
- **Proverbs 16:18** “Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.” (NIV)
- **Isaiah 27:1** “In that day, the Lord will punish with his sword—his fierce, great and powerful sword—Leviathan the gliding serpent, Leviathan the coiling serpent; he will slay the monster of the sea.” (NIV)

Discussion

Pride and arrogance are represented by Leviathan in the Bible, as said in Job 41:33-34 that he is the king of pride over all his children. He is referred to as a creator of chaos, a twisting serpent that causes division and confusion. His pride causes deception, twisting of truth, and a resistance to God and His truth. Pride is also the sin that expelled

Lucifer from heaven. The book of Isaiah 14:12-14 and Ezekiel 28:12-17 both tell the story of pride found in Lucifer and the resulting desire to be exalted above God. In Revelation 12:7-9, it talks about the war in heaven where Michael and his angels, fought against the dragon. The great dragon, the ancient serpent, known as the devil or Satan, who deceived the whole world, was thrown down out of Heaven along with his angels.

Prayer

Father God, Please forgive me for any way that I have been prideful or arrogant. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of pride, arrogance, rebellion, self-exaltation, and deception. I repent and renounce the dragon (Satan) and every source of his demonic power, the beast of the sea and all forms of the Antichrist power, the devil, Lucifer, Leviathan, and any other symbolic beast or demonic power that causes chaos or strife and is an enemy of God. I thank you, God, for making my crooked paths straight, for keeping my heart humble and my eyes fixed on You. I ask for the fear of and reverence for You only, God, to come upon me, and that You alone, God, will get all the honor and all of the glory.

In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 19 – Death / Suicide

Bible Verses

- **Matthew 18:14** “Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish.” (NKJV)
- **John 10:10** “The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.” (NKJV)
- **Jeremiah 1:5** “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you” (ESV)
- **Romans 8:11** “And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of His Spirit who lives in you.” (NIV)
- **1 Corinthians 6:19-20** - “Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.”(NIV)
- **Revelation 1:18** “I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.”(NKJV)

Discussion

Genesis 1 & 2 tell how man and woman were made in God's image, and His own breath breathed life into them. Psalm 139:13-18, tells a beautiful story about God knitting us together in our mother's womb, ordaining all of our days before one came to be, and how precious His thoughts are toward us; so many thoughts that they could outnumber the grains of sand on the sea shores. The 6th commandment of the Ten Commandments is (Exodus 20:13) "You shall not murder." Any form of murder of a human being is sin, this includes suicide and abortion of a child. Suicide is self rejection and self hatred resulting in oppression and the murder of self. Abortion which has sadly become very common and is considered a medical procedure by many, is the sin of murder of an already known human being knit together in the mother's womb by God Himself. The pressures of fear or to escape pain need to lead us to God's rescue instead of the theft of the thief, who only comes to steal, kill and to destroy.

Prayer

Father God, Please forgive me for my sins and the sins of my ancestors. If I have harbored anger or contempt toward a brother or sister, or toward anyone, I ask You to help me forgive them. I choose now to forgive them. I release them, and I ask that You bless them. I repent and renounce and break every generational curse of murder, death, suicide, suicidal ideation, abortion, genocide, infanticide, worship or sacrifice of children to Molech or Baal, and any other gods, goddesses, or demons. I repent and renounce all shame, fear, rage, anger, revenge, and vengeance or condemnation resulting from these acts. I forgive myself and anyone else involved in the murder of any human being, even in the womb. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 20 – Casting Out Demons / Binding and Loosing

Bible Verses

- **Matthew 10:8** “Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.” (NKJV)
- **Matthew 16:19** “I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.” (NIV)
- **Mark 9:29** “So He said to them, ‘This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.’” (NKJV)
- **Mark 16:17** “And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues.” (NIV)
- **Luke 8:31** The demons kept begging Jesus not to send them into the bottomless pit. (NLT)
- **Luke 10:19** “Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.” (NKJV)

Discussion

(Matthew 16:19) Jesus has given us the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven.

What we bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and what we loose on earth is loosed in heaven. (Luke 10:19) He has given us the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, that nothing will by any means harm us. He gave us the great commission in (Mark 16:15-18) where He told them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." When we are under the authority of Jesus, we have the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, the authority over all the powers of the enemy, and the commission to preach the gospel, cast out demons, and nothing will hurt us.

Prayer

Father God, I thank you for sending your Son, Jesus, who died for my sins. I thank you that through Jesus' sacrificial death and resurrection, I have been redeemed. I declare that I am fully submitted to my Lord Jesus Christ. It is no longer I who live but Christ that lives in me (Galatians 2:20). I thank you, God, that the same power that raised Christ from the dead is in me. I have been given the keys, the authority, and the commission to go to bring the gospel to all nations, but also over all the power of the enemy. I repent and renounce all my sins and all the sins of my ancestors on my mother's side and father's side, all the way back to Adam and Eve, and for the generations going forward. I bind every spirit that is not of the Holy Spirit that came in through any of these sins and I command them to leave me now and go to the pit, never to return. I declare that all of God's blessings that belonged to all of my generations are loosed over my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 21 – Battle in the Mind

Bible Verses

- **Romans 12:2** “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”(NIV)
- **1 Corinthians 2:16** “For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.” (NKJV)
- **2 Corinthians 10:5** “Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.” (NKJV)
- **Galatians 2:20** “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” (NKJV)
- **James 4:7-8** “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.”(ESV)

Discussion

There is a battle for your mind and your thoughts. How do we hold every thought captive in obedience to Christ? The first thing is learning to discern your own thoughts, what is from God, and what is from the enemy. Everything good is from God; everything that is not good is not from God. If your thoughts are condemning or make you feel shame or any other negative emotion, they are from the enemy. Even if God is giving you some correction or discipline, He does it in a way where you feel the Father's love with the correction, and usually, there are instructions or steps on how to restore. When the enemy speaks, there is usually confusion, and it repeats or plays in your head. When God speaks, He speaks into your heart and your whole being, and you know in your innermost being it was God. As we grow, all believers are to study what the Bible says, grow up in Christ and keep making choices to submit our thinking and our ways to God's wonderful ways that bring wisdom and blessing.

Prayer

Father God, I thank you for helping me to discern and recognize your voice. I thank you for helping me to be transformed by the renewing of my mind, and helping me to hold every thought captive. I ask you, Father, to cleanse my mind to help me focus and meditate on your Word that has the power to transform my mind. I repent and renounce all ungodly thoughts, all the lies of the enemy that I have believed, all negative emotions, thoughts, and beliefs. Father, I ask you throughout my day to help me submit to you and resist any thoughts that are not from You. I thank you for helping me cast down imaginations, arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of you, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 22 – Prayer of Protection / Filling with The Holy Spirit / Assigning Angels

Bible Verses

- **Psalms 91:11-12** “For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.”(NIV)
- **Isaiah 54:17** “No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me,” says the Lord.”(NKJV)
- **Matthew 28:19** “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”(NIV)
- **Luke 11:13** “So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?”(NLT)

Discussion

Once we’ve walked through repentance, renounced sin, broken unhealthy soul ties, forgiven others, dealt with generational patterns,

and shut the door on the enemy, the next step is learning how to stay free. Freedom isn't something we obtain and forget—it's something we maintain. As believers, the first commandment is to keep God as our first love. This includes staying connected to Him through reading the Bible, praying, worshiping, praying in tongues, and walking in genuine fellowship with other believers. Just as important is being mindful not to reopen doors to the enemy through ongoing or willful sin. It's a lot like physical health. You can technically survive without eating well, sleeping, or exercising—but over time, you'll grow weaker. In the same way, spiritual disciplines don't make us children of God—we already are through Christ—but they keep us strong, alert, and healthy in our faith. Another key step is water baptism. Jesus instructed His disciples to baptize new believers as a public expression of faith and identification with Him. Baptism is a powerful declaration that our old life is gone and we now belong to Christ. Daily prayer also matters. Praying the Lord's Prayer from Matthew 6:9-13, declaring God's protection through Psalm 91, and intentionally putting on the Full Armor of God from Ephesians 6, help keep us spiritually prepared and aware. These prayers don't come from fear—they come from confidence in God's covering and care. God has good plans for us, and He is faithful to finish the work He started in us. He even gives us the gift of the Holy Spirit when we ask—empowering us, strengthening us, and helping us pray when we don't know what to say. Praying in tongues is a heavenly language that builds us up from the inside out, anchoring us in faith and keeping us aligned with Him. Freedom is a gift—but walking it out daily is how it stays strong.

Prayer

Father God, I thank you that You are my deliverer, my healer, and my Father. I thank You that You have set me free from bondage. I ask You

to place a fiery hedge of protection around me. I ask that any demonic portal that I opened or was opened on my behalf be shut now and sealed with the Blood of Jesus. That every demonic altar built against me be torn down and burned up with the Fire of God. I declare no weapon formed against me will prosper. I thank You God for Your Heavenly Hosts, Your warring angels, being assigned to me to minister day and night until I am set free from everything that is binding me. You are a good Father who gives good gifts to His children. I ask for the gift of Your Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. Father, please fill me and baptize me in Your Holy Spirit. I declare, from Psalms 91, a prayer of protection and from Ephesians 6:10-20, the full Armor of God over me and my family. As Joshua 24:15 says, “But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.”
